

# Contract for volunteers in United Rescue Aid

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This agreement has been made available to me, since I will start to work as an active volunteer within United Rescue Aid (URA).

I hereby declare that I accept the responsibility to volunteer within United Rescue Aid. I agree to follow the rules and regulations, code of conduct, that has been made available to me through members group in Facebook and URA's website.

If I refuse to do so, I'm aware of the potential termination of my contract and thereby ending my work in URA. I understand and agree, that all work that takes place within URA, is voluntarily, legal and serves no financial interest for myself as an individual.

I understand and accept, that I will never use my work in URA to promote myself financially or in other ways take advantage of the situation or my position as URA volunteer.

I understand and agree, that information that I get from my work in URA is confidential and that I will only be allowed to share it outside URA, if there is an agreement between myself and management about sharing it.

I understand and accept, that if I break this contract, I will be immediately banned from all work while an investigation takes place. If I at any time, would want to terminate this agreement and stop working in URA, I will do so by informing management and write a statement saying so to; [info@unitedrescues.eu](mailto:info@unitedrescues.eu)

I understand and accept that it is NOT allowed to terminate agreement and stop working in the middle of a shift and in the process endanger lives.

\* By using alternative 1, I will be able to start working within URA as soon as it's done. I understand that it's optional, which alternative I use and I also understand that by doing both of them I will be able to start working sooner and will also get a certificate about my role in the organization.
